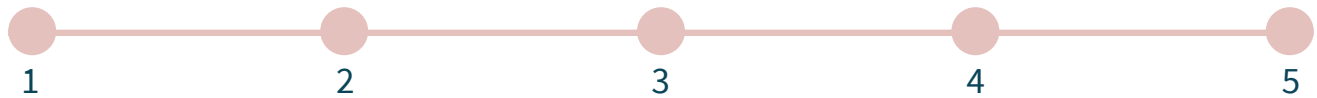

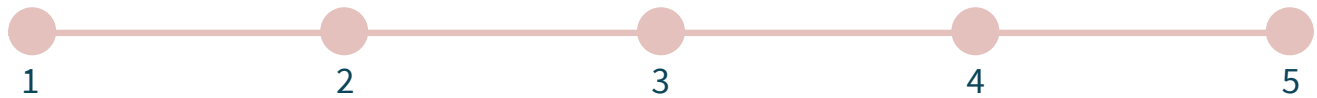
Answer the following questions honestly, rating each one on a scale from 1 - 5

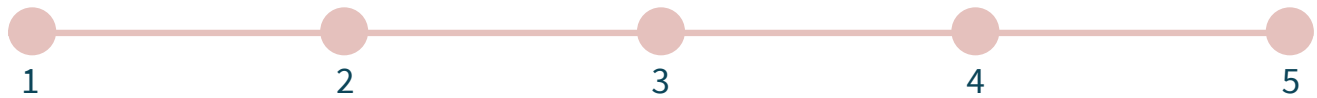
I'm a visionary. I'm always looking to the future, setting goals, and making plans.



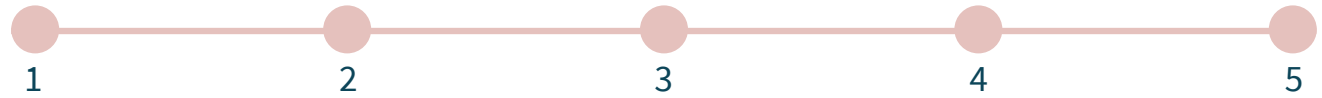
I demonstrate empathy, engaging in active listening, and building meaningful working relationships with staff and parents.



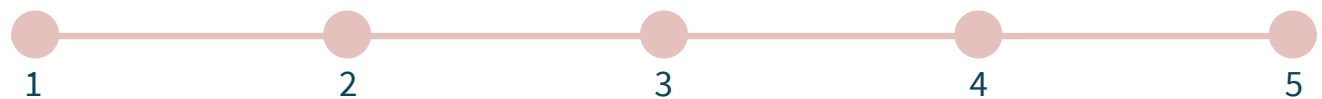
I lead by inspiring and motivating others instead of controlling and using fear and threats.



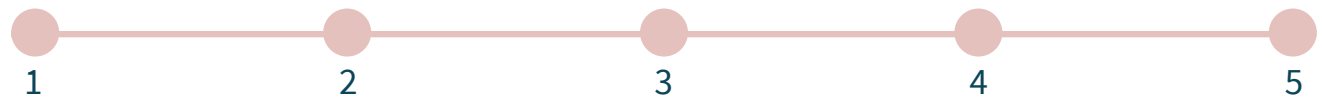
I have a servant's heart. I check in daily and ask my staff if there is anything they need or if there is any way you could support them to make their day better.



I lead by example. I'm not afraid to jump in and help staff when needed.



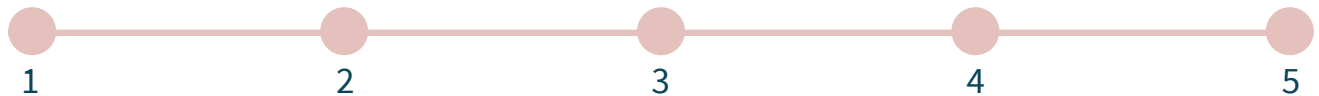
I am open to new ideas, possibilities, and perspectives, and understanding that there's no "right" way to do things. I realize that I do not always have all the answers.



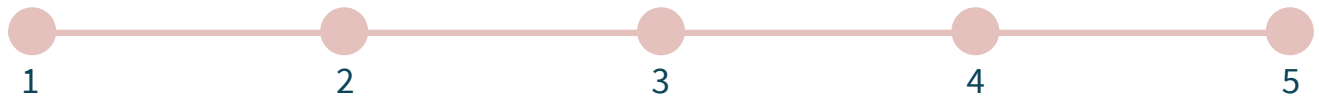

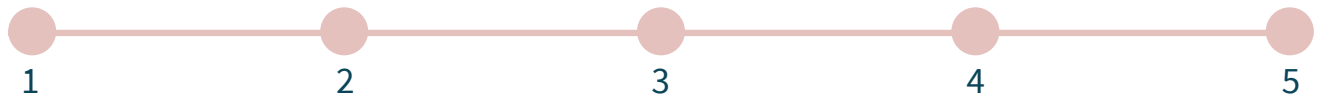
I give teachers the power to manage their class. I give them guidelines but let them have freedom to come up with their own ideas, crafts, and plans.



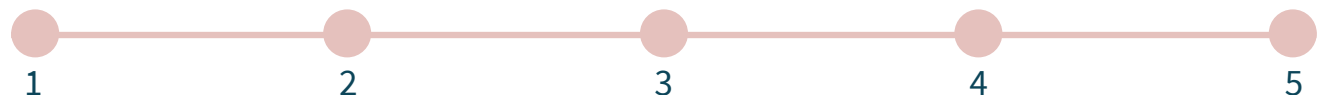
I have an open line of communication with my staff and often communicate expectations, goals, big wins, opportunities for improvement, future plans, policies and procedures.



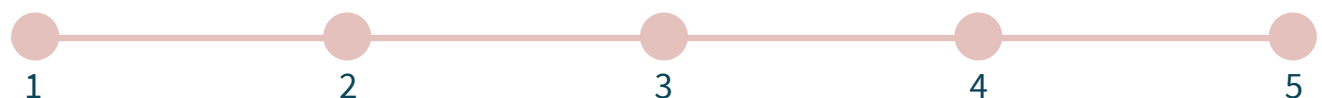
I go out of my way to give recognition for excellent work. I encourage my staff often and give sincere appreciation on a regular basis.
